Dear M'am/Sir,

I am writing as an advocate to the animals you are using in your food recipes. I wish you already know the conditions that the poor birds have to go throughout their lives, to be able to produce eggs for us, still if you don't, I wish to enlighten you a little.

The factory farming of egg-laying hens is replete with cruelty. The birds are cramped wing to wing and nearly immobilized their entire lives.

India is the third largest egg-producing country in the world with approximately 120 million egg-laying hens that are bred in cruel, commercial battery cages which are typically less than an A4 size sheet of paper and are named so for the way they are stacked on top of the other in the form of batteries.

Keeping hens in battery cages are more likely to harbor Salmonella, which is found in retail eggs and is a major cause of food poisoning in India.

I urge you to reduce or eradicate the usage of eggs from the baked items in your food menu, for egg replacers are easily available, healthy and cruelty free.
